- A size H crochet hook
- Scissors
- Yarn needle

Instructions

1. To start, make a slip knot and chain 4.
2. Slip stitch into the first chain to form a ring.
3. Chain 3 (counts as first double crochet).
4. Work 11 double crochets into the ring.
5. Slip stitch to join the round.
6. Chain 3 (counts as first double crochet).
7. Work 2 double crochets into each double crochet around.
8. Slip stitch to join the round.
9. Chain 3 (counts as first double crochet).
10. Work (double crochet, chain 1) into each double crochet around.
11. Slip stitch to join the round.
12. Chain 3 (counts as first double crochet).
13. Work 3 double crochets into each chain-1 space around.
14. Slip stitch to join the round.
15. Chain 3 (counts as first double crochet).
16. Work (double crochet, chain 2) into each double crochet around.

17. Slip stitch to join the round.
18. Chain 3 (counts as first double crochet).
19. Work 4 double crochets into each chain-2 space around.
20. Slip stitch to join the round.
21. Chain 3 (counts as first double crochet).
22. Work (double crochet, chain 3) into each double crochet around.
23. Slip stitch to join the round.
24. Chain 3 (counts as first double crochet).
25. Work 5 double crochets into each chain-3 space around.
26. Slip stitch to join the round.
27. Finish off and weave in any loose ends.

Tips

- You can use any color of yarn you like to make your coasters.
- If you want to make your coasters larger, simply work more rounds.
- You can also add embellishments to your coasters, such as beads or sequins.
- These coasters make great gifts for friends and family.

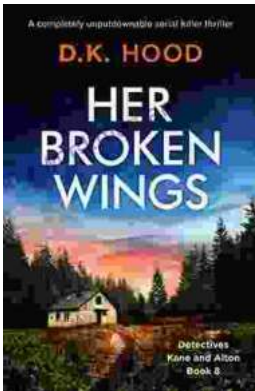

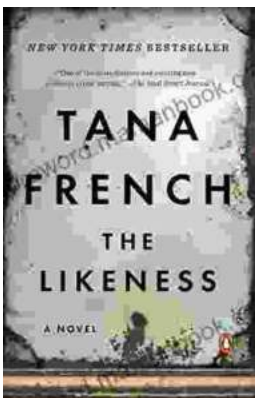
