Materials

- Worsted weight yarn in green, red, and white
- Crochet hook size H (5.00 mm)

- Yarn needle

Abbreviations

- ch - chain
- dc - double crochet
- sl st - slip stitch
- sc - single crochet
- hdc - half double crochet
- tr - treble crochet

Instructions

1. With green yarn, ch 6 and join with a sl st to form a ring.
2. Round 1: Ch 3 (counts as a dc),dc 11 into the ring. Join with a sl st to the top of the ch-3.
3. Round 2: Ch 3, 2 dc in each dc around. Join with a sl st to the top of the ch-3.
4. Round 3: Ch 3, *dc in the next dc, 2 dc in the next dc; repeat from * around. Join with a sl st to the top of the ch-3.
5. Round 4: Ch 3, *dc in the next 2 dc, 2 dc in the next dc; repeat from * around. Join with a sl st to the top of the ch-3.
6. Round 5: Ch 3, *dc in the next 3 dc, 2 dc in the next dc; repeat from * around. Join with a sl st to the top of the ch-3.
7. Round 6: Ch 3, *dc in the next 4 dc, 2 dc in the next dc; repeat from * around. Join with a sl st to the top of the ch-3.

8. Round 7: Ch 3, *dc in the next 5 dc, 2 dc in the next dc; repeat from * around. Join with a sl st to the top of the ch-3.
9. Round 8: Ch 3, *dc in the next 6 dc, 2 dc in the next dc; repeat from * around. Join with a sl st to the top of the ch-3.
10. Round 9: Ch 3, *dc in the next 7 dc, 2 dc in the next dc; repeat from * around. Join with a sl st to the top of the ch-3.
11. Round 10: Ch 3, *dc in the next 8 dc, 2 dc in the next dc; repeat from * around. Join with a sl st to the top of the ch-3.
12. Round 11: Ch 3, *dc in the next 9 dc, 2 dc in the next dc; repeat from * around. Join with a sl st to the top of the ch-3.
13. Round 12: Ch 3, *dc in the next 10 dc, 2 dc in the next dc; repeat from * around. Join with a sl st to the top of the ch-3.
14. Round 13: Ch 3, *dc in the next 11 dc, 2 dc in the next dc; repeat from * around. Join with a sl st to the top of the ch-3.
15. Round 14: Ch

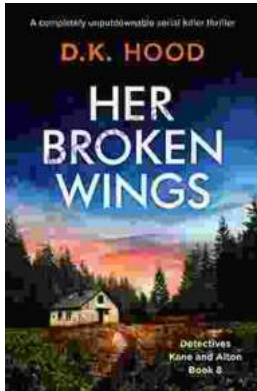

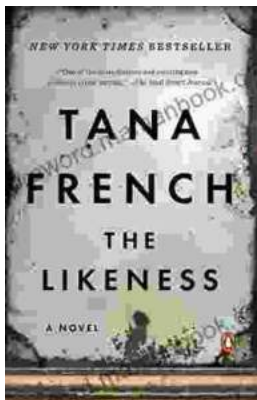
