Materials

1. Bernat Blanket yarn (recommended colors: white, black, orange, and green)
2. Crochet hook size H (5mm)
3. Yarn needle
4. Black embroidery floss
5. Fabric stuffing

Instructions

Part 1: Body

1. **Round 1:** With white yarn, make a magic ring. 6 sc in ring. Pull ring closed and sl st to first sc. (6)
2. **Round 2:** 2 sc in each sc. (12)
3. **Round 3:** *1 sc, 2 sc in next sc.* Repeat * around. (18)
4. **Round 4:** *1 sc in each of next 2 sc, 2 sc in next sc.* Repeat * around. (24)
5. **Rounds 5-9:** 1 sc in each sc around. (24)

Part 2: Head

1. **Round 1:** With white yarn, make a magic ring. 6 sc in ring. Pull ring closed and sl st to first sc. (6)
2. **Round 2:** 2 sc in each sc. (12)
3. **Round 3:** *1 sc in each of next 2 sc, 2 sc in next sc.* Repeat * around. (18)

4. **Rounds 4-6:** 1 sc in each sc around. (18)

Assembly

1. Sew the head to the body, leaving an opening for stuffing.
2. Stuff the pillow with fabric stuffing.
3. Sew the opening closed.
4. Embroider the eyes, mouth, and carrot nose on the snowman's face.
5. Add a scarf and buttons for decoration (optional).

Tips

* Use a larger hook size for a looser fabric and a smaller hook size for a tighter fabric. * Be sure to count your stitches regularly to ensure accuracy. * If you run out of yarn in the middle of a round, simply knot a new piece to the end of the old piece and continue crocheting. * Don't be afraid to experiment with different colors and embellishments to create a unique and personalized pillow.

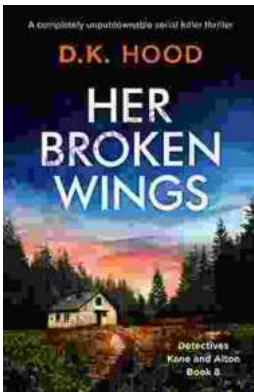

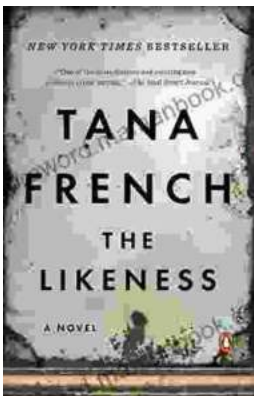
