
Papalotes: The Songs of Texas Graham

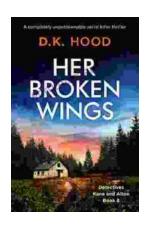


